management of the workflow of diagnostics and treatments of hospitalized animals by other specialty services in the Intermediate Medical Care (IMC) ward. The faculty assignment could include daytime, swing, or weekend work. Members of the veterinary faculty must contribute to a team environment, engage productively with referring veterinarians, and collaborate with colleagues. Faculty members are expected to provide exceptional patient care while simultaneously providing clinical instruction for veterinary students and house officers.

Review of applications will commence on November 1, 2023, and will continue until qualified applicants are recommended for appointment. Starting salary will be commensurate with experience and credentials. Full-time faculty are eligible for full university benefits.
