mammalian), livestock (horses, cattle, small ruminants, camelids, poultry), companion animals (dogs and cats), and laboratory animals. The position also requires clinical training of veterinary and postdoctoral students in large animal pathology. Applicants must have a DVM/VMD degree, ACVP board certification, and expertise in diagnostic animal pathology, including wildlife. Excellent communication and writing skills are required. Salary will be commensurate with the candidate's training and experience.

The search committee will begin considering applications immediately; applications will be reviewed until the position is filled. The anticipated starting date of employment is December 1st, 2019.
