within the department are also expected. The successful candidate will be expected to establish and maintain an energetic, extramurally well-funded research program; engage in interdisciplinary and collaborative research; as well as teach in the graduate or veterinary professional programs. A strong track record of peer-reviewed publications as well as evidence of a potential for teaching and mentorship are desired. The successful applicant must also possess excellent interpersonal and communication skills with a demonstrated ability to work with others in a collegial team atmosphere. An excellent start-up package and an incentive program are available for this position.

The Department of Comparative Biomedical Sciences (<https://lsu.edu/vetmed/cbs/index.php>) features research programs in basic and translational research in diverse areas of biomedical sciences including cancer biology, cardiovascular disease, developmental biology, neurosciences, pharmacology and toxicology. The Department currently has twenty faculty members with a growing research program in toxicology, supports graduate programs at the MS and PhD levels, and currently has seven post-doctoral researchers, and twenty-two graduate students.
