This is a full time, 12-month tenure track position with the academic appointment in the Department of Veterinary Science. The initial appointment will be at the assistant or associate professor rank, with an annually expected assigned distribution of effort of 90% service and 10% research. The anticipated start date is September 1, 2020, and the appointment is subject to formal approval by the University administration and the Board of Trustees.
