relation to humans, animals, and the environment. Possibilities exist for the development of a new undergraduate course or courses (with options to include graduate coursework) depending on the individual's area of expertise.

Applications received by **December 15, 2024**, will be given full consideration, although applications will continue to be taken on an ongoing basis, and the position will be kept open until it is filled.

Minimum Qualifications

Minimum qualifications include a Master of Public Health (MPH or MSPH) or equivalent, or an advanced degree (e.g., MS, DRPH, or PhD) in a closely related health or preventive medicine discipline at the time the appointment begins.

The successful candidate must meet eligibility requirements for work in the United States at the time the appointment is scheduled to begin and continue working legally for the term of employment.

Desired Qualifications
